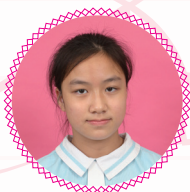

Greetings, Peter. It has been a long time since we talked. How was your weekend? Mine was terrible. It was like a disaster. Let me share my unforgettable experience with you.

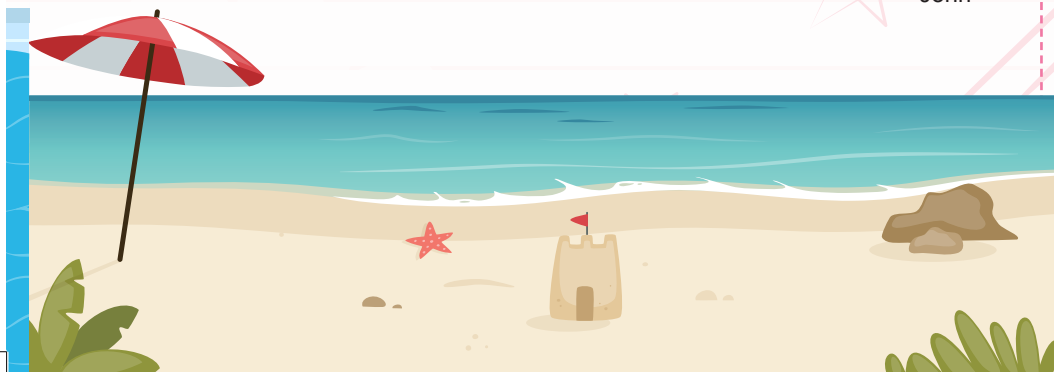

## The 13<sup>th</sup> Zodiac Sign

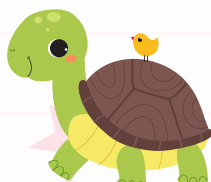
